Dear Landowner:

Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, L.L.C. ("Tennessee") previously notified you of its plans to construct the Northeast Energy Direct Project ("Project"). Tennessee developed the Project, which would expand and modify its existing pipeline system in Pennsylvania, New York, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Connecticut, to meet the increased demand in the northeast United States, particularly in New York and New England, for transportation capacity for natural gas. On November 20, 2015, Tennessee filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") a certificate application for the Project in Docket No. CP16-21-000. The certificate application was noticed by the Commission on December 7, 2015. Since you were identified as a landowner affected by the Project, Tennessee notified you by letter of the Project's certificate application filing after that date.


On April 22, 2016, Tennessee submitted a letter to the Commission requesting that the Commission not take any further action in processing the certificate application, pending Tennessee submitting a status report to the Commission no later than May 26, 2016. The April 22, 2016 letter was filed following Kinder Morgan, Inc., Tennessee's parent company, announcing on April 20, 2016 that the company would suspend further work and expenditures on the Project, as a result of inadequate capacity commitments from prospective customers and a determination that the Project is uneconomic.

Tennessee, on May 23, 2016, filed a notice of withdrawal of the Project certificate application with the Commission. As you were identified as an affected landowner for the Project, Tennessee is providing this notification letter to you.
