# 2012 Hudson Residential Recycling and Solid Waste Service Guide

This Service Guide contains important dates and collection information, please read and keep this information.

## TOWN CLEAN-UP DAYS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012

- Each residence serviced by curbside collection will be entitled to **THREE CLEAN UP DAY PASSES** per calendar year.
- Passes are valid for that calendar year for which they are issued, and will expire on December 31 of every year.
- Passes may be obtained at the Highway Department during normal business hours or at the landfill during clean up days.
- Residents will be required to show a valid picture ID to be issued passes for their address. The address will be prominently displayed on the pass and is valid for that address only. A valid picture ID will also be required on the clean up day to match to the pass.
- A pass will be required to dispose of any acceptable items per visit. Not per day.
- No additional passes are allowed nor can they be purchased for a fee. The Highway Department will prepare and maintain a resources list for available alternatives for disposal.
- The town is not responsible for lost or stolen passes and will not issue replacements.

**\$30.00:** All freon appliances, TV's & CRT monitors, and non-metal goods (plastic appliances, couches, mattresses, rugs, etc.)

**\$20.00:** All metal appliances

Collections for the week of a holiday will be postponed by one day if your trash day falls on or after the following holidays:

- Memorial Day: Monday, May 28, 2012
- 4th of July: Wednesday, July 4, 2012
- Labor Day: Monday, September 3, 2012
- Thanksgiving Day: Thursday, November 22, 2012
- Christmas Day: Tuesday, December 25, 2012
- New Year's Day: Tuesday, January 1, 2013

**Acceptable Items:** Demolition and Building Materials, Clean Sheetrock, Clean Asphalt Shingles, Clean Wood, Brush, Leaves, Furniture, Rugs, Cardboard, Appliances and Scrap Metal. (Branches should be no greater than 5 inches in diameter.)

**\$10 User Fee per Vehicle:** Covers 10 gallons or 20 pounds. Cash or check payable to NRSWMD

**Accepted Items Include:** Pesticide, Insecticide, Herbicide, Rodent Killer, Drain Cleaner, Varnish, Coal Tar Driveway Sealer, Muriatic Acid, Antifreeze, Mixed Gasoline, Paint Thinner, Oil & Lead Based Paint, Paint Stripper, Oven Cleaner, Photo Chemicals, Ni-CAD & Lithium batteries, Pool Chemicals. \*\*\* NO LATEX PAINT \*\*\*

# RECYCLING INFORMATION



These materials should be placed in a recycling bin or barrel. Please remember that 80% of your discarded items are made up of the materials listed below. There is no cost to the Town of Hudson for the disposal of these commodities. You are encouraged you to remove these items from your general trash and help save the Town substantial disposal costs which are funded from your tax dollars.

## PAPER PRODUCTS

### What Can Be Recycled:

### How To Prepare It:

- Do not place paper to be recycled in plastic bags.
- Cardboard should be flattened and no bigger than 2 feet wide & 3 feet long. Ripped into smaller pieces is acceptable.
- Shredded paper should be placed in a paper bag with top folded down, or put under other objects so as to not blow away and cause litter.

### Unacceptable Items Do Not Recycle The Following:

- Waxed paper
- Soiled paper
- Used tissues

*Recycling bins are available free of charge to Hudson residents at the Hudson Highway Department during normal business hours.*

*You may also use trash cans for your recycling (one for Mixed Paper and one for Commingled). They are larger so they hold more items and most come with lids to keep items contained.*

## COMMINGLED CONTAINERS

### What Can Be Recycled:

- All plastic containers #1-#7 (beverage containers, tubs, laundry detergent containers, etc.)
- Plastic shopping bags stuffed into each other (see below)
- Clear, brown, green, & blue glass containers used for foods and beverages ONLY
- Tin and steel cans
- Metal lids to jars or bottles
- All aluminum cans & pet food cans
- Aluminum foil, disposable pie tins, & aluminum baking trays



### How To Prepare It:

- Keep all plastic, metal, and glass in the same bin or barrel, but separate from paper products.
- Plastic shopping bags should be scrunched up and stuffed into other plastic shopping bags (the "bag of bags"). If possible place under heavier objects to prevent litter.

### Unacceptable Items Do Not Recycle The Following:

- Needles
- Foam Rubber
- Light Bulbs (ESPECIALLY FLUORESCENTS)
- Ovenware, Ceramics
- Styrofoam
- Containers for hazardous or toxic materials (paint, rat poison, gasoline, etc.)
- Propane Tanks
- Window Panes
- Appliances

- Tire Warehouse, Hudson: **disposal fee for tires**
- Hudson Highway Department: **free disposal of motor oil**

### New Law: Fluorescents & Mercury-Containing Items

As of January 1st, 2008 New Hampshire State Law prohibits throwing items containing mercury (thermometers, thermostats, fluorescent bulbs) into the trash. Mercury is a very toxic substance and requires special handling.

### KEEP FLUORESCENT BULBS, COMPACT FLUORESCENT BULBS, THERMOMETERS, AND THERMOSTATS OUT OF YOUR TRASH!

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON AUTOMATED TRASH COLLECTION

## Guidelines for Automated Trash Collection

Please read this resident user guide completely. It contains important program information

- All trash should be bagged and placed in the automated collection cart issued by the Town of Hudson.
- Trash left beside the cart or in other containers will not be collected.
- Collection cart lids should be closed.
- Collection carts must be set in an accessible location: At least 5 feet from any obstruction such as trees, telephone poles, parked cars, mailboxes, recycling bins and barrels, etc. Approximately 2 feet from the curb and away from low hanging utility lines.
- Trash carts may be placed in groups of two, where applicable.
- Carts that are inaccessible will not be serviced until the following week.
- The cart must be placed so that the handle faces the house.
- All carts must be at the curb **by 7:00 AM** on your trash day.
- No hazardous or building materials, yard waste, brush, or recyclables should be placed in trash carts.
- Recycling bins and barrels should be placed on the curb itself so as to not interfere with the trash collection process.
- All recycling bins and barrels must be at the curb **by 7:00 AM** on your trash day.
- Recycling bins and barrels may be up to 32 gallons in capacity, there is no limit to the number of recycling bins or barrels you may use.

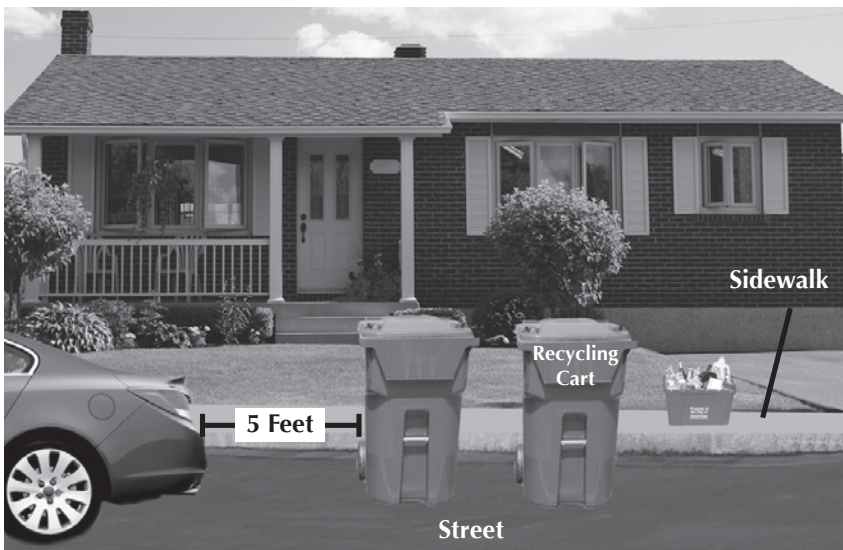
## Cart Information & Barcoding

Hudson Residents will receive one cart free as part of the automated collection program. This cart is the property of Pinard Waste Systems and should not be defaced or modified in any way. You are encouraged to remove all the recyclable items out of your regular trash, before purchasing a second container. This will reduce the volume in your trash significantly. The recyclables you remove save the Town of Hudson a substantial amount of money; money which comes out of your taxes!

**Note:** All carts are bar-coded to the residential address to which the cart is placed. When purchasing a second collection cart you will notice that it is a different color lid, than the free cart provided by the Town of Hudson. This cart is also bar coded to the residence to which it is delivered. No residential address may have two free cart colors. If this happens the cart will be scanned and returned to the correct address.

## Missing or Damaged Carts

If for some reason the cart is destroyed, a new cart will be provided free of charge upon the return of the damaged cart. Missing carts will be replaced upon notification to Pinard Waste Systems. Damaged carts will be repaired at no cost to the resident. Call Pinard Waste Systems at 1-800-675-7933. Please detail the nature of the needed repair. (Lid, wheel, etc.)



## Proper Placement for Curbside Collection

- Place recycling bins and barrels on curb
- Place collection cart 2 feet from curb, and at least 5 feet from any obstruction (ie. parked car or tree).

On one way streets, carts should be placed on the right-hand side of the street.
