

Update on Eagles Nest Subdivision Activity, off Hawkview Road & Bush Hill Road (March 8, 2016)

A “Selective Cut” of timber on the Eagles Nest property is currently taking place. “The work that folks see going on at the end of Hawkview Road involves refreshing the logging yard that was previously used for the same purpose at the same location”, stated, John Gargasz, Principal Owner of the Eagles Nest Subdivision.

Mr. Gargasz further stated, “Per our agreement with the Town of Hudson, road construction activity will commence via Bush Hill Road. However, road construction work has not started yet. On a side note, our wetland permit, requires the creation of a cottontail rabbit habitat, which requires a clear cut of approximately 10-15 acres. This habitat will be located near the center of the development, out of sight of any neighbors.”

Mr. Gargasz concluded by saying, “I would like to emphasize, that we are not starting the road construction activity, as yet, but I can understand that residents may have that perception when they see the logging activity. A start date for construction of the development has not been set”.
