Citizen Police Academy

The Citizen Police Academy is a nine week program aimed at introducing the many programs the Hudson Police Department offers our citizens. Our Citizen Police Academy Program is one of the most worthwhile community policing tools we offer. It provides our citizens with the opportunity to spend time at the department with the officers, and it truly shows that officers are everyday people. We receive nothing but positive feedback from attendees.

AARP Driver Safety Program

The American Association of Retired People Driver Safety Program (AARP DSP) is the nation's first and largest classroom driving refresher course designed for drivers age 50 and over.

The Driver Safety Program is one of AARP's hallmark programs and helps AARP fulfill its key social impact goal of "helping Americans age 50+ sustain mobility as they age." The Hudson Police Department provides this training in an attempt to help individuals retain their driving competencies and their driving privileges to the maximum extent possible. Minimal course fee of \$15.00 for AARP members & \$20.00 for those who are not AARP members.

Good Morning Hudson Seniors

This program was developed in an attempt to make sure our senior population can remain independent for as long as possible. Upon completion of an application, the Hudson Police will send you a confidential questionnaire to complete; providing us with information regarding your home, health concerns, and names of close relatives.

As a participant in this program, you are required to call our Communications Division every morning between 7:30 and 10:00. If Communications personnel do not hear from you by 10:00 AM, they will send an officer to your residence to check on your well-being.



Operation Safe Return

Our "Operation Safe Return" program is designed to assist "memory challenged" individuals. Any resident of the community who is impaired, or has a family member who is impaired, may apply to participate in this program.

The participant will be issued an ID bracelet/necklace which will have a number engraved on it. A confidential record containing the identification of the applicant and names of emergency contacts will be listed under that number. When an officer has contact with a subject who is lost or disoriented, the ID bracelet/necklace will assist the officer in making a "Safe Return."

The Vial of Life

This program is available to the senior population and individuals who live alone and have concerns about medical emergencies. The "vial" is a pill bottle which contains the participant's medical diagnosis, medications, doctor and hospital preferences, as well as information regarding listed emergency contacts. A red heart decal is prominently placed on the refrigerator door in your home, which is where the "Vial of Life" bottle is kept. In the event of an emergency, this red heart will indicate to responding personnel, that important medical information is available inside a vial in the refrigerator. Any Hudson resident can register in the Vial of Life Program.
