Curbside Recyclables: Items that will not fit into your family’s Blue Tote/Cart or to purchase an additional Blue Tote/Cart (\$100) contact the Hudson Highway Department 886-6018

Batteries and Light Bulbs: Cars, tractors/mowers: Trade in old batteries when buying new one • All types of *rechargeable* batteries including car & truck can be turned in with **no fee** at Batteries+Bulbs 883-5060 Amherst St. Nashua They also accept spent light bulbs, fluorescent tubes and more – Call for information • Regular household batteries (AAA-D) can go into your black trash bin

Carbon Monoxide Detectors: Most do not contain radioactive material and can be put into the trash *after* removing the battery

Smoke Detectors: They contain radioactive material and must be returned to the manufacturer. Visit www.nashuarpc.org/hhw for a current list of addresses by manufacturer

Used Oil: Hudson Highway Department 886-6018 During office hours, Most stores that sell oil accept used oil at no fee including Auto Zone on Derry St. and Walmart on Lowell Rd. both in Hudson

Packing Peanuts and Bubble Wrap: UPS Store 882-1877 Lowell Rd. Hudson

Pills and Medicines: Prescription and over the counter to Hudson Police Dept. 886-6011 Drop off medicine in original container with personal name removed See “drop-box” in vestibule

Plastic Bags - All Types Including Ziploc: Hannaford, Market Basket, and Walmart – all in Hudson

Propane Tanks: CAN NOT be brought to the Landfill or put in the trash!
Hudson True Value 883-3100 Derry Rd. Hudson (accepts old propane tanks for a fee of \$8.00/ea. If purchasing a new tank the fee is waived) • AmeriGas 432-2521 Liberty Dr. Londonderry (free 20lb tank disposal)

Syringes and Epi Pens: St. Joseph Hospital 882-3000 - Drop box in closet behind Information Desk in main lobby • Southern NH Medical Center 577-2000 - Drop Box at entrance to emergency room
Each item must be in a closed “hard shell” container of any type.
