**Warrant Article 1
Operating Budget**

Shall the Hudson School District vote to raise and appropriate an operating budget , not including appropriations by special warrant article and other appropriations voted separately, the amount set forward on the budget posted with the warrant as amended by the vote at the first session totaling \$50,530,617? Should this article be defeated, the operating budget will be \$50,417,963 which is the same as last year with certain adjustments, required by previous action of the Hudson School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting under RSA 40:13X and XVI to take up a revised operating budget only. Majority vote required.

Operating Budget estimated tax impact: \$.51
Default Budget estimated tax impact: \$.46

Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Hudson School Board and the Hudson Federation of Teachers**

Shall the Hudson School District vote to approve the cost items in the collective bargaining agreement between the Hudson Federation of Teachers, Local 2263 AFT-NH, AFL-CIO and the Hudson School Board which call for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels over the amount paid in the prior fiscal year: 2016-17 \$281,768, 2017-18 \$529,310, 2018-19 \$541,532, 2019-20 \$538,479, 2020-21 \$447,064 and to further raise and appropriate the sum of \$281,768 for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement that would be paid under current staffing levels. Majority vote required.

Shall the Hudson School District vote to raise and approve the cost items in the collective bargaining agreement between the AFSCME Local 1906, School Administrators, and the Hudson School Board which call for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels over the amount paid in the prior fiscal year: 2016-17 \$137,728 and to further raise and appropriate for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement that would be paid under current staffing levels. Majority vote required.
