Topic:

1. Prime Wetlands – Presentation for Planning Board Meeting of June 2, 2010
 - Review of document “Town of Hudson – Prime Wetland Lot Impacts from 50 Ft to 100 Ft”
 - Study limited to those Prime Wetlands that were classified as High Value in the Prime Wetland Study and impact was on existing structures
 - Maps have been provided to J Cashell for handouts at the meeting
 - Need to identify Map and Lot number for two properties located on Vernon St.

2. Open Space Plan – Review of Open Space Plan
 - A few minor corrections made.
 - Plan is to have available for ConCom Acceptance at June 8 meeting.

3. Town Forrest – Condition of Trail Markers.
 - A site walk of the Town forest was conducted on May 23 Attended by J Battis and T Quinn
 - Several problems were found
 - Some Trail Markers were not visible due to brush overgrowth
 - Some Trail Markers had labels peeling off.
 - Two Trial Markers had been damaged by apparently by being struck by ATVs
 - A container for ammunition was found discarded in the meadow area
 - The entrance sign needs refinishing, however it appears the work is minor and may be able to be done on site.
 - Evidence of ATV damage in wet areas
 - Parking is extremely limited. T Quinn to pursue possible of clearing an area with Kevin Burns
