## 7. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Votes taken after Nonpublic Session on October 9, 2018
  - 1) Motion by Selectman McGrath, seconded by Selectman Routsis, to hire Benjamin Savage for the position of Firefighter/EMT in the Fire Department at the contracted starting salary of \$16.11 per hour (step 1) effective October 28, 2018. This assignment will be a non-exempt position in accordance with the International Association of Firefighters Local #3154 as per the union contract, carried 5-0.
  - 2) Motion by Selectman McGrath, seconded by Selectman Martin, to hire Jess Forrence as the Director of Public Works with an annual salary of \$100,000. After six month's probationary period and subject to review, increase to an annual salary of \$103,787. Effective October 9, 2018, carried 3-2. Selectmen Morin and Routsis in opposition.

### 10. NONPUBLIC SESSION

**RSA 91-A:3 II** (a) The dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted;

- (b) The hiring of any person as a public employee;
- (d) Consideration of the acquisition, sale, or lease of real or personal property which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general community; and
- (e) Consideration or negotiation of pending claims or litigation which has been threatened in writing or filed against the public body or any subdivision thereof, or against any member thereof because of his or her membership in such public body, until the claim or litigation has been fully adjudicated or otherwise settled. Any application filed for tax abatement, pursuant to law, with any body or board shall not constitute a threatened or filed litigation against any public body for the purposes of this subparagraph.

THE SELECTMEN MAY ALSO GO INTO NON-PUBLIC SESSION FOR ANY OTHER SUBJECT MATTER PERMITTED PURSUANT TO RSA 91-A:3 (II).
