7. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Votes taken after Nonpublic Session on July 8, 2014
 - 1) Motion by Selectman Brucker, seconded by Selectman Nichols, to hire Shara McIntosh as an HCTV Camera Operator Regular Special Shift Employee effective July 9, 2014 at \$11.00 per hour, carried 4-0. (Selectman Maddox voted in favor as Shara doesn't report directly to her father, Jim McIntosh.)
 - 2) Motion by Selectman Nichols, seconded by Selectman Maddox, to promote Scott Tice to the position of Deputy Fire Chief, effective July 13, 2014. This assignment will be an exempt position and in accordance with the Police, Fire and Town Supervisors Association, with an annual salary of \$87,965 (Step 5) and then to Step 6 at the completion of probation," as recommended by the Fire Chief, carried 4-0.
 - 3) <u>Motion by Selectman Brucker, seconded by Selectman Nichols, to authorize the Fire Chief to transfer Kevin Grebinar to the position of Suppression Captain, effective July 17, 2014. This assignment will be a non-exempt position and in accordance with the Police, Fire and Town Supervisors Association, with an annual salary of \$78,166 with a required 6 (six) month probationary period as recommended by the Fire Chief, carried 4-0.</u>
 - 4) <u>Motion to adjourn at 9:28 p.m. by Selectman Maddox, seconded by selectman Brucker, carried 4-0.</u>

10. NONPUBLIC SESSION

RSA 91-A:2 (a) Strategy or negotiations with respect to collective bargaining;

RSA 91-A:3 II (a) The dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted; and

(c) Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.
