A. Votes taken after Nonpublic Session on September 10, 2012

- 1) Motion by Selectman Maddox, seconded by Selectman Luszey, to authorize the Fire Chief to hire Lenwood Brown, III, to the position of Firefighter EMT-I within the Fire Department beginning on September 30, 2012. This assignment will be a non-exempt position and in accordance with the IAFF Local #3154 Contract with an hourly rate of \$14.58 per hour and then to Step 1 at the completion of the probation as recommended by the Fire Chief, carried 4-0.
- 2) Motion by Selectman Maddox, seconded by Selectman Luszey, to hire Colby Morton effective October 1, 2012 with a starting salary of \$20.98 per hour according to Police Union Local #3657 Contract, carried 4-0.
- 3) Motion by Selectman Luszey, seconded by Selectman Brucker, to conditionally hire Sean West effective October 1, 2012 with a starting salary of \$20.98 per hour according to Police Union Local #3657 Contract, carried 3-1. Selectman Maddox in opposition.
- 4) Motion by Selectman Brucker, seconded by Selectman Luszey to hire Thomas Traverso as the part-time Animal Control Officer at a salary of \$15.50 per hour, 24 hours a week (Saturday, Sunday, and Monday), effective October 1, 2012, carried 4-0.
