- 3. Committee updates
 - a. Selectmen: Budget books are available
 - b. School Board: Focus has been on Budgets and Contracts
 - c. Conservation Commission: Prime Wetland Study, Open Space plan, Ottarnic and Robinson Ponds

- 5. Review of Town Budget Book, and Tax Rate Setting Process led by Kathy C.
- 6. School Overview
 - a. Per pupil spending is \$2700 below state average (\$7.3K vs \$10K)
 - b. Hills Garrison Bond paid off
 - c. Health Insurance cost down 5% not up 10% as expected

- d. Overall Spending down \$930K and Revenue up \$500K
- e. Added \$400K of facilities projects. Pays dividends
- f. 2010 Budget is \$41.6 mil 2009 Budget was \$41.5 mil Down .9%
- g. Looking to do a real technology plan using outside help
- h. State funds are up because we now show more than 5% of students below the poverty line.
