i. Police

- Presented by Chief Avery. Discussion related to body cams, shields and tasers. The BC unanimously agreed that these devices should be captured under the operating budget related to purchase and end of life rebuys. The Police have three warrant articles for FY22 to include a CRF that will support the above listed devices as a backup to the operating budget.
- To capture the fully funded requirement for tasers, body cams and shields the BC voted to add \$13,100 to the FY22 operating budget and all subsequent budgets. Tasers and body cams were already captured. The additional \$13,100 is to fund the shields portion of these three items.
- Motion made by Mr. Trost second by Mr. Guessferd to add \$13,100 to 5671-403 to fund new Police protective shields. Motion passed (10-0-0).
