II. New Business:

A. Current Projects in the Works presented by E Dhima

1. CMAQ Lowell Road Widening: Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Haffner's to the highway ramp \$1.5M total 80/20 (\$1.2M/\$.3M) approved Federal grant to add lane
2. Wason Road Widening: from plaza entrance to Lowell Road add lane for improved right turn access estimated \$0.5M total proposed CMAQ 80/20 for 2022
3. Lowell Road Widening (near Pelham Road) add lane for north bound right turn onto Pelham Road estimated \$0.25M
4. Lowell Road and Birch Street Traffic Flow Improvements request of Planning Board includes traffic, bridge and waterway with County Road becoming one way from Lowell Road north bound until Jette Field, extending Belmont Road to the light at Birch Street, reconfiguring the bridge that currently exists on Lowell Road and re-directing the flow of water west bound from the bridge that frequently overflows

During discussion it was determined that road projects within the Town can only improve the flow the traffic, but not reduce the volume, which should be considered a regional concern with focus on East/West routes that are almost non-existent.
