I. OLD BUSINESS

Musquash Conservation Area/ Town Forest Work Day

The Chairman reviewed progress made by local community volunteers and members of the HCC on installation of new sign posts and other work that took place on the trail system of the Musquash Conservation Land. He thanked all those who had an opportunity to attended the work day.

A. Saving Special Places (Work shop Discussion)

A: NHDES Shore-Land Water Quality Protection Act (SWQPA)

The HCC members present reviewed and discussed RSA 483-B Shore-land Water Quality Protection Act and standards set by NHDES. The handout dealt current rules regarding the Protected Shore-land, Natural Woodland Buffer Limitations and Waterfront Buffers.

B: Erosion Control Methods Discussion

The HCC members present reviewed and discussed a hand out published by the NHDES on Erosion Control within. a Protected Shore-Land. HCC members discussed various issues related to poor erosion control efforts and different methods that could be used by developers to help mitigate problems associated by storm water runoff.
