New Business

Selectman Luszey suggested that we begin to have the meetings broadcast on HCTV. Lori Bowen stated that she would call Mike O'Keefe and try to coordinate getting the Senior Affairs Committee meetings broadcast on HCTV.

A chair recliner was donated to the Senior Center from Sam's Club. It was recommended that a list of items be assembled to perhaps make a list available to the public to ensure that what items are need for the senior center are known,. This could result in be made available to the public to ensure that items that are needed are fulfilled. It was also recommended that a Registry be developed to also ensure that items that are needed are fulfilled.
