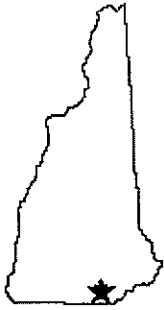

RE: Town Hall / Central Fire Parking Area

As we have worked through the installation of the new antenna tower at Central Fire, we have developed concerns for the traffic pattern behind Town Hall. After a lengthy evaluation and discussion, we come to you with a proposal to change the traffic pattern behind Town Hall and Central Fire to a one-way from Chase Street, east to Library Street.

This pattern change will eliminate westbound traffic from the new antenna tower to where the gas pump is located. By eliminating the two-way traffic, we will reduce the possibility of an injury, or accident in the area of the new curbing around the tower as well as reducing the possibility of two-way traffic at the bollards for the tower. This will also allow us the opportunity to increase the size of the parking spaces to accommodate larger vehicle parking for personnel and town vehicles.

This change will not affect any customer parking but will require customers to enter from School Street if they choose to drive behind the building. As you are aware, we are in the process of reclaiming, grading and paving behind Town Hall and this easy change will result in a minimal expense that would include simple signage and notifications through internal posting and social media.

I have enclosed the proposed signage, but would defer to the Director of Public Works for his opinion and expertise. Please feel free to contact me at your leisure with questions, concerns or comments.
