- III. Review of previous meeting
 - a. Strobe lights in the red lights at Ferry and Library Streets on the Ferry Street facing lights are in progress.
- IV. Items to Discuss
 - a. Closing Memorial Drive
 - i. Discussed traffic using Memorial Drive during the school day. HPD to follow-up and this will be revisited at the August HSC meeting.
 - b. Install guardrail 33 Boyd Rd
 - i. Reviewed the email sent by Bob Calzini of 33 Boyd Rd which describes his concern of motor vehicle accidents on the corner by his house and the potential of a vehicle coming into his yard. He requests the HSC to consider installing a guardrail or looking at other options to increase safety. The Town Engineer will develop a template for third party reviews and consider the possibility of having a third party engineering firm review the situation and make recommendations in funding is available. HPD will review accident data for this area to help determine the need for additional measures. DPW states that they have a limited budget to install and repair guardrails. They will try to increase this budget item in the future. We will revisit this at the August HSC meeting.

- c. Traffic using Ledge Rd as cut through
 - i. Reviewed an email sent by John Nevin of 15 Ledge Rd which describes his concerns about traffic using Lindsay St and Ledge Rd as a cut through. He stated these drivers are exceeding the speed limit, create noise, and leave trash along the road. HPD will conduct directed patrols in the area, post the speed control signs in the area, and post the traffic data collection devices in the area.
