Mr. Webster will coordinate with the Highway Department to replace the lines in conjunction with work that the Highway Department is doing in these areas.
- 4. The interns have been updating the maps of the distribution system and adding all the new valves and fire hydrants. This is the first time the maps have been updated in 14 years.
