A. Hudson Logistics Center Amended Site Plan & Conditional Use Permit SP# 12-22

CU# 07-22 Map 239/Lot 001

Brian Kutz of Hillwood and Jay Leonard, Attorney for Green Meadow Gold Course introduced themselves and the itinerary for the site walk which would be conducted with the use of golf carts.

The purpose of the site walk was to view the differences between the approved plan and the current application, particularly as it relates to the southern boundary that abuts a residential zone and the proposed wetland impacts.

The site walk consisted of 11 stop areas. 10 of them were accessible by golf cart. References below to the term "Approved" means the improvements previously approved under Site Plan/CUP decisions in 2021 while "Amended" means an improvement proposed under the current Site Plan/CUP applications.

- 1. Parking Area (located approximately in the middle of Approved Building C)
- 2. Southeast Corner of the Amended Building
- 3. Southwest Corner of the Amended Building
- 4. Amended Sound Fence
- 5. Southwest Corner of Approved Building B
- 6. Approved Sound Fence
- 7. Approved Sound Fence
- 8. Amended Sound Fence
- 9. Southeast Corner of Approved Building C
- 10. Wetland Crossing
- 11. Norther Driveway (end of Sam's Club access road, not accessible by golf cart, personal vehicles were used)

@10:20 a.m., the site walk of the golf course concluded and moved to stop #11, Northern Driveway, accessed by personal vehicles. Crowley, Etienne, Morin, and Ulery left at this time.
