Purpose of Request: to waive the requirements of item §193-10.C – Establishment of grades. Waiver Acceptance & Hearing.

Ms. McGrath voted to grant a waiver from §193-10.C of the Driveway Regulations – Establishment of Grades, to allow driveway grades of up to 14%, based on the Board's discussion, the Town Engineer, the testimony of the Applicant, and in accordance with the language included in the submitted Waiver Request Form for said waiver.

Ms. McGrath moved to schedule a public hearing on January 22, 2020, for an amendment to the Wetland Conservation Overlay District; Article IX, Wetland Conservation District.

2. Duplexes; Article II, Terminology, §334-6 Definitions: DUPLEX; to clarify definition of Duplex buildings; Attachment 4, Table of Minimum Dimensional Requirements, to require greater lot size for duplexes than single-family homes.

Mr. Van der Veen moved to schedule a public hearing on January 22, 2020, for an amendment to the §334-6 Definitions: DUPLEX; to clarify definition of Duplex buildings. (McGrath against lot size increase, and Dumont against lot size increase & definition).

3. Building Height in Industrial Zones; Article III, General Regulations, § 334-14 Building Height; to include Map 251 Lot 1, "BAE Systems" in the allowance for 50-foot building height in select industrial zones.

The Town of Hudson is currently dealing with a significant safety issue at Lowell Road and Sagamore Bridge intersection. Selectmen Morin, Town Administrator and Town Engineer met with Department of Transportation staff regarding this matter and agreed that installing a 360 degrees Blue Light would help enforcement. This light activates when vehicles run a red light and is 360 degrees visible for police officers.

Our traffic contractor has provided the cost of the equipment and labor, please see attachment quote:




