#### VI. OLD BUSINESS

A. Colbea Enterprises, LLC Site Plan SP# 09-23

14 Brenton Ave, 7 Atwood Ave, & 91, 95, 97 Lowell Rd Map 198/Lots 11, 12, 14, 15, & 16

Purpose: to depict the construction of a proposed gas station with convenience store, consisting of six (6) dispenser islands for a total of twelve (12) fueling stations, along with a proposed car wash, and associated improvements including but not limited to, access, grading, stormwater management, utilities, lighting, and landscaping (**Deferred from the March 26, 2025 meeting**).

Ms. Paquin recused herself. Mr. Boyer seated for Ms. Paquin.

Mr. Oates moved to deny without prejudice the site plan application for Colbea Enterprises, LLC Site Plan – Gas Station/Convenience Store w/Drive-Thru/Car Wash, Non-Residential Site Plan SP# 09-23, Map 198 / Lots 11, 12, 14, 15, & 16, 14 Brenton Ave, 7 Atwood Ave, & 91, 95, & 97 Lowell Road, Hudson, New Hampshire, for the reasons set forth in the Staff Report prepared for the May 28, 2025 Public Hearing. \*The Planning Board waived the Application Fees for the future submittal. Motion seconded by Mr. Hall. All in favor – motion carried 7/0/0.

Ms. Paquin reseated. Mr. Boyer returned as Alternate.

#### VII. NEW BUSINESS

A. Taybre Drive Subdivision Plan SB# 03-25

9 Alvirne Dr. & 190 R Derry Rd. Map 138/lots 082 & 088

Purpose: to consolidate Map 138/Lots 082 & 088 into one (1) lot, known as Map 138/Lot 088, and depict the subdivision of Map 138/Lot 088 into nine (9) single-family residential lots, with all associated improvements. Application acceptance & hearing.
