Mr. Ulery moved to approve the 09 July 2025 meeting minutes Motion seconded by Mr. Crowley. All in favor – motion carried 7/0/0.

VI. CORRESPONDENCE

- A. Request for Corridor Funds Elvis Dhima
 - Lowell / Birch / Belknap Road Right of Way Purchase & Wetland Impact Fees

Mr. Oates moved to recommend to the Board of Selectmen the expenditure for establishment of a Right of Way connecting Belknap Road and Lowell Road using Corridor Account #'s 2070-000-701 and 2070-000-702 funds received after August 2018, not to exceed \$200,000.00, in accordance with the request made by Elvis Dhima, Town Engineer.

Motion seconded by Mr. Crowley. All in favor – motion carried 7/0/0.

Mr. Crowley moved to recommend to the Board of Selectmen the expenditure for efforts related to wetland impacts using Corridor Account #'s 2070-000-701 and 2070-000-702 funds received after August 2018, not to exceed \$215,000.000, in accordance with the request made by Elvis Dhima, Town Engineer.

Motion seconded by Mr. Hall. All in favor – motion carried 7/0/0.

- B. Bond Reduction Request by Jay Minkarah, Interim Town Planner
 - Target Site First Landscape Bond Reduction

Mr. Crowley recused himself @ 7:17 P.M. Mr. Boyer seated for Mr. Crowley.

Mr. Ulery moved to approve a bond reduction of \$3,526,462.84 leaving a balance of \$1,923,757.16 for the Target Flow Center, in accordance with the recommendation of the Interim Town Planner, Jay Minkarah.

Motion seconded by Mr. Boyer. Motion carried 6/1/0 (Oates).

Mr. Crowley reseated @ 7:22 P.M. Mr. Boyer returned as Alternate.

A. Brady Drive Industrial Condominium Complex Site Plan SP# 09-25
