On March 3, 2019 at 3:30 PM, members of the Hudson Police Department responded to 2 Tate Street for the report of a disturbance. While on the way to the residence, officers also learned that a male subject, known to others in the house, was armed with a firearm. Upon the officers' arrival they were able to successfully enter the residence, contact the male subject, secure his firearm and detain him. The male subject was identified as Serge Michaud, 57, of 2 Tate Street.

On scene, the officers discovered that there was a domestic related disturbance between Michaud and other family members in the residence, and during the verbal altercation Michaud armed himself with a firearm. It is alleged that while inside the residence Michaud fired his handgun into a wall, which exited his residence and penetrated the front of the house located at 1 Tate Street. Additionally, it is suspected that Michaud went to the rear of his residence and fired several more rounds toward the backyard. Michaud was taken into custody and charged with three counts of felony domestic violence Criminal Threatening, six counts of felony Reckless Conduct and two counts of Unauthorized Discharge of a Firearm. No one was injured.

Michaud is being held with no bail, and there will be a bail hearing on March 4, 2019 at 1:00 PM at the Nashua Superior Court.
