CHAPTER 154-9 FALSE ALARMS	
A. Any owner or lessee of property having an alarm system and any user of ala and installed with the intent of eliciting a police, fire or ambulance response, charge of \$50 for each false alarm in excess of two in a twelve-month per of this chapter. [Amended 3-9-2004]	shall pay the Town of Hudson a service
B. There shall be a service charge of \$100 for each false alarm in excess of four in any twelve-month period. [Amended 3-9-2004]
