#### CHAPTER 154-9 FALSE ALARMS

- A. Any owner or lessee of property having an alarm system and any user of alarm services or equipment designed and installed with the intent of eliciting a police, fire or ambulance response, shall pay the Town of Hudson a service charge of **\$50 for each false alarm in excess of two** in a twelve-month period, commencing with the effective date of this chapter. [Amended 3-9-2004]
- B. There shall be a service charge of **\$100 for each false alarm in excess of four** in any twelve-month period. [Amended 3-9-2004]

#### CHAPTER 154-4 PERMIT FEES

Effective July 1, 2004, there is a \$15.00 renewal fee due every three (3) years.

All persons 65 years of age or older who are the principal occupants of the residence shall be exempt from all permit fees but shall comply with all other requirements of this chapter.
