## Freedom Field II Update

Dave Yates has met with the town engineer a few times both in the office and on the field. The estimate by the town engineer was $\$ 271,000$ to build the field. We have $\$ 180,000$ right now so we are still down about $\$ 90,000$. It was recommended to build the field in phases and save money. The estimate included the cost of the fence wich was $\$ 50,000$. If we held off the first year on the fence it would cut the cost down. Dave also spoke with HUSC president and has a verbal agreement that will soon be written up, releasing the rights to the second field.
