

4. Approval of Minutes – January 24, 2011

5. Old Business

Review of Trash Tonnage Report – January is down from December. The goal still remains 30%. Connie was able to confirm that the recycling truck had two bins in the front showing that the front loaded truck can still be a dual stream vehicle. The town is still currently under a dual stream contract.

Power Point Presentation Status – No status update due to absence of Tim due to business travel

HLN Column Status – Cheryl has completed and submitted her next column to the HLN primarily focused on the composting bin sale. Suggestion of the committee to base the next column on the single vs. dual stream recycling and clarifying the differences and the town's contract.

Banner Status – Frank can drop off banners after election day to all the schools. They will be distributed by the winning slogan from the school will get the banner. Frank will drop off the banners to the schools. Lisza to draft a document or letter to see if we could get some cooperation and promotion of the recycling program at the 3 major ball fields, Lions, Hills and Greeley, to increase participation.

Compost Bin Sale Proposal – Connie has no compost bin sales figures as of yet. Connie has received some orders via the phone. The order form is available at the town hall and through the recycling section of the town web site.

Report on Deliberative Sessions – Most members of the committee attended the deliberative sessions and supported recycling.

Upcoming Events Calendar – Election day is on the 3/8/11. Frank will set up at 7am, Connie will cover during the mid morning slot and Frank will be there with



some student volunteers at around 5pm till close. Frank will then pack up the materials. Cheryl brought up an invite to Kiwanis indoor yard sale. Cheryl will get the particulars on time and will forward to committee to arrange coverage of table at the event.

2011 School Contest – Frank will contact the schools with a communication of the contest. Frank has partially created the scavenger hunt / quiz and will send the preliminary copy to the committee. Frank will also send the copy of the rules to the committee as well. The committee will discuss potential prizes at our next meeting. Input from citizens – Recycling Truck

Inventory of table materials – The inventory was taken by Frank and the committee agreed that the supplies were in fine shape.

Election of Officers – The position of Chairperson will remain with Connie Owen. Both Frank and Connie were nominated and after discussion the committee decided to retain Connie as Chairperson. Reuse, reduce and recycle class – Connie is attending a class that involves reusing recycled items. Lisza will contact the person that runs the class to get some ideas for activities for the summer program. The Board of Selectmen have requested some recycling material (videos or presentations) to fill time on breaks during BOS meetings. The committee is looking into possible solutions.
