ITINERARY

Day One: You will depart from the Senior Center at 7:00 a.m. for a 3-day adventure to the Saratoga, New York area. A “Drink and Drain” (rest stop) en route to the Saratoga Race Course for a fun afternoon of racing. The Saratoga Race Course is a Thoroughbred horse racing track located in Saratoga Springs, New York. It opened in 1863, and it is often considered to be one of the oldest major sporting venues of any kind in the country. Races start at 1:00 p.m. and go every 30 minutes. Lunch will be on your own today. Later, you will check into your hotel for your 2-night stay in the charming city of Glens Falls, New York. The historic Queensbury Hotel has welcomed guests for nearly 100 years. Well-appointed accommodations, quality service and exquisite meals are just the start. The hotel is located near the Lake George and Saratoga Springs regions in the Adirondacks and across the street from City Park in the quaint city of Glens Falls. Your group will receive a warm welcome upon arrival with a reception in the grand lobby and express luggage assistance to your room. Your delicious dinner will be held here tonight. In your free time, you may choose to walk downtown and see the shops and restaurants, or take a dip in the heated indoor pool and Jacuzzi.

Day Two: A Buffet Breakfast will be served right at the hotel and is included. This morning you will have a local guided tour of the Saratoga area. Learn about the history, health and horses on this interesting tour. Lunch today will be on your own in Saratoga, where you can grab a bite to eat and browse the shops of this beautiful city. This afternoon, you will have a tour of the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame. The guided tour lasts about 90 minutes and includes a 45-minute guided tour of the museum with a knowledgeable docent, and a special private screening of their signature film, “What it Takes: Journey to the Hall of Fame.” After the tour is concluded, you are welcome to explore the gift shop or any other parts of the museum you want to see at your leisure. This evening you will have time to gamble at Saratoga’s own Saratoga Casino Hotel. The Casino offers over 1200 slots, video poker, Keno and electronic table games, restaurants and entertainment. Try your hand at Lady Luck! Dinner will be on your won tonight.

Day Three: Breakfast is again included before your check-out, and you will then travel to the village of Lake George where you will have time to enjoy the shops and scenic area before going over to the Lake George Steamboat Company for your narrated 2-hour luncheon boat ride, on the sparkling waters of Lake George. The Lac du Saint Sacrament is one of 3 boats owned and operated by the Lake George Steamboat Company, in existence since 1817. Lake George is also known as “The Queen of American Lakes” and is 32 miles long. You will get to enjoy a delectable buffet luncheon on board this delightful boat, and entertainment will be provided for your listening and dancing pleasure. After your boat ride, you will be heading home with many wonderful memories of Saratoga and Lake George! Thank you for traveling with Royal Tours!
