ITINERARY

DAY ONE: On this 2 day /1 night Holiday Tour, you will get into the Holiday Spirit after visiting Newport. This morning you will be visiting The Newport Car Museum. The Newport Car Museum opened in mid-2017 in a former missile manufacturing facility situated on seven acres of land in Portsmouth, R.I. Since, it has won numerous awards and the favor of large audiences typically reserved for museums with longer histories. The private collection of some 85+ automobiles at the Newport Car Museum focuses on seven decades of modern industrial automotive design and celebrates cars as works of art. From the 1950s to the present, separate galleries of Ford/Shelby Cars, Corvettes, World Cars, Fin Cars and Mopars and American Muscle: "Then & Now" have been carefully curated to appeal not just to grandfathers, fathers and teenage sons but to men and women of all ages. This is not your typical Car Museum!

Next, you will have time for some shopping and lunch, on your own in Newport. This afternoon, your group will have a self-guided tour of one of Newport's spectacular mansions, The Marble House. This will be the first of two that you will be touring. William Vanderbilt built Marble House as a 39th birthday present for his wife, Alva. It was a social and architectural landmark that set the pace for Newport's subsequent transformation from a quiet summer colony of wooden houses to the legendary resort of opulent Gilded Age mansions. Prepare to be dazzled by the exquisitely decorated trees to complement the décor and theme of each room. Hundreds of poinsettias, garlands, wreaths and fresh floral arrangements add color, warmth and life.

You will be staying at the Wyndham Newport Hotel in Middletown, RI (401-236-2020). The Wyndham offers modern accommodations, exceptional amenities, and spectacular water views. A contemporary hotel located just three miles from Newport. Take a relaxing dip in their heated indoor saltwater pool, work out in their state-of-the-art fitness center, a restaurant and bar, gift shop are just some of the hotel's amenities. The spacious rooms have king-size beds (even the doubles! there are 2 beds!), free WIFI, hair dryer, mini refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, flat screen tv, and more. You will have time to freshen up before your plated dinner (included) at the Newport Playhouse. After dinner, you will see a live performance of "On the Farce Day of Christmas."

To keep her religious mother from knowing she's divorced, Wendy pays her ex-husband to accompany her to her parents' home in Utah for Christmas and pretend they are still happily married. DAY TWO: A delicious breakfast is included this morning before you tour the second Newport Mansion, The Elms. Edward J. Berwind's opulent summer estate is a stunning symbol of Gilded Age ambition. The Elms was molded after an 18th century French Chateau but featured the latest technology of the Gilded Age. It housed an outstanding collection of paintings, statuary and tapestries, and its landscape features formal gardens, terraces, pavilions and fountains. The Elms will also be decorated with festive Holiday finery! When your tour is completed, you will be having lunch back at the Wyndham in Johnny's Restaurant.
