Earth Day Review:

Cheryl motions to cover Dibbles' extra expenses. Rob seconded.

In Favor: Rob, Lisza, Cheryl Kathy, Debra

Against: Leo, Mike Abstain: Linda **Motion passes**

Leo commented that he voted against it because the Bouncy House contributed to the overage. Ben Dibble offers that there was a really nice article in the HLN. That same day there was a huge event at Benson's. We should look at holding it with them next year to get some of those people. Debra agrees. The 2 goals of the Earth Day are to 1) promote Recycling, Energy and 2) promote the Boy Scouts.

4. Approval of Minutes: Minutes from the March 28, 2016 meeting have not been released by Mike. Minutes were not distributed. Will vote on them next month.

5. Reports:

- Review of Trash Tonnage Report
 - Had ideas on increasing recycling. Rob suggested promoting recycling bins in the home.
 Deb asked if anyone gave the Recycling Stickers away for free. Lisza said that we can ask the place where we get out blue bags from.
- Expenditure Report
 - We are well within out budget. We spent some but we have plenty. We have sufficient money to do what we want to do.

 - Got email from family that helped at Roadside cleanup last Saturday. The mom indicated a strong interest to becoming part of the Sustainability Committee. Deb asked Lisa to reach out to her.
 - Cheryl wrote a great article a week before the cleanup. It got us great press and brought the residents up-to-date
 - o Schools have occasionally checked in on competition and Deb forwarded these to Lisza.
 - o There will be a May article. People to forward ideas to Cheryl.

Energy Items

- At the Earth Day Party, a representative of the company that did Curious About Solar was there and advertised.
- Mike T: Mike had Action Item to follow up on Solar Street Lights. Vendor would like an opportunity to speak next month. Mike will attempt to schedule him for the May meeting.

2016 Earth Day and the spring Roadside Cleanup

- 24 families signed in. Low turnout was likely due to people spending time outside (at Benson's)
- Lisza thought that Cleanup went well. Meeting place was ideal. People who drove by tooted and gave a thumbs up.
 - Took advantage of landfill being opened for the day. Musquash, Burns Hill, Some of Wasson. Collected 29 blue bags and 11 Black bags.
 - Met Mr. Thompson who lives on Burns Hill. He was still working after this count and doing a great job.
 - Had 2 families.
 - Ideas: Used nylon green bag with our logo on it to hold trash bags. It would be helpful. Buy these instead of T-Shirts
 - Red Brick would do this. They already have our logo and it is a one-size-fitsall.
 - Lisza will investigate the price, send a quote out before the next meeting, and report next month

 Choose one. Advertise in Hudson. Informational meetings and ads in the HLN. The installation company chosen pays for all of the promotion not residents and not our committee.
 - Linda: Solarize will be focus of our committee now that other major events are done. Any of us can be on the committee as private members but not as SC members.

- **Deb:** Spoke to someone about the number of alcohol containers on the road and the person said the reason is the open container law. But people shouldn't be drinking and driving. There are people still on wells in this town; if you pollute you can contaminate the water supply
- **Mike:** Sorry he couldn't make cleanup. Regarding the tonnage reports, do we have enough historical information so that we can see trends. Maybe we shouldn't get discouraged too quickly.

- **Kathleen**: Not only do they throw the trash out the window, they throw it far into the ditch. People need to "clean up their act"


