Town Clean Up Proposal

Intro/Purpose: After polling the Hudson NH Residents Facebook page the Hudson Sustainability Committee would like to streamline the process to hold town/roadside clean-ups to make them safe while limiting the number of resources we need to complete the task.

Current Process for all clean ups: Contact BOS, Hudson PD, DPW for approval of all road clean up events.

Goals/Objectives:

- Hold 6+ town/roadside clean ups each year
 - 1-2 primary (as defines below) road clean ups
 - 3-6 secondary (as defined below) road clean ups
- The road type (as defined below) would decide the amount of town resources needed

Volunteers: All volunteers must be 18+ and sign a liability waiver (attached) for all volunteer clean ups.

Road type 1: Defined as busy primary town roads with no or limited shoulder space for safe passage of volunteers (examples: Watson Rd, Bush Hill Rd, Kimball Hill Rd etc)

Resources: Contact Board of Selectman, Town Police Department, DWP for **approval** of road clean up dates **two months** prior to clean up. Coordinate with DPW for trash/recyclable pick up.

Road type 2: Defined as primary town roads with wide shoulder for safe passage of volunteers (examples: Ledge Rd, David Dr, Pine Rd)

Resources: Contact Board of Selectman, Town Police Department and DPW to **notify** of road clean up dates **one month** prior to clean up. Coordinate with DPW for trash/recyclable pick up.

Road type 3: Defined as secondary town roads such as neighborhoods, roads with sidewalks or dead end roads (examples: Stevens Dr, Old Robinson Rd, Standish Ln, McKinney Dr)

Resources: Contact DPW to **notify** of road clean up dates **one month** prior to clean up and coordinate trash/recyclable pick up.
