Hudson Transfer Station: The next two upcoming dates are November 27 and December 18 (8:00am-12:00pm) 2021 Transfer Station Pass Needed 3 free per year per household, one pass needed for each drop off. Passes may be picked up only at the DPW offices Monday through Thursday 6am 4pm, 2 Constitution Drive, Hudson. December 18<sup>th</sup> is the last date the Transfer Station will be open. The Transfer Station will be open each Saturday for yard waste, metal and cardboard drop-offs 8am-12noon through December 18<sup>th</sup>!
- Curbside Yard Waste Collection: Saturday, December 4. Have all leaves in Bio-degradable Leaf Bags. Brush should be bundled with twine and no larger than 2 feet in diameter and 3 feet long. Put all at the curb in front of your home BY 7:00am. Do not go by when your trash or recycling is normally picked up.

- 9. Contract for Trash and Recycling 2022–Renewal with Pinard Waste Systems. Don't go solely by whether an item has a triangle! Plastic and Glass Bottles, Jars, Tubs, Jugs – if it did NOT come with a lid or cap --- ITS TRASH. Electronics of any type are E-Waste – Must be handled properly – Electronics Recycling events hosted in Town of Hudson regularly by the Scouts and Rotary. NO Plastic Bags in the Blue Bin!– drop off clean bags for Hudson Lions Club

- **10. FREE Radon Testing kits:** NH Radon Program is offering free test kits to NH residents. Simply visit the website, <u>https://aelabs.com/nh</u>, to order and one will be sent to you with instructions on how to perform the test and a postage paid return envelope. Once the test is complete, please mail it back and allow 2 weeks to receive your test results.
