

ARTICLES

Warrant Article 1:

Shall the Hudson School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant article and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant as amended by vote at the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$44,890,226? **YES**

Should this article be defeated, the operating budget shall be \$44,905,769, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments, required by previous action of the Hudson School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13X and XVI to take up a revised operating budget only. **NO**

Warrant Article 2:

Shall the Hudson School District vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement between the Hudson School Board and the Hudson School District Secretaries, AFT-CIO, which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits:

2011-12	-0-
2012-13	\$21,729 (2% increase)
2013-14	\$22,164 (2% increase)

And further to raise and appropriate no funds for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at the current staffing levels in accordance with the most recent collective bargaining agreement? **YES**
