- 4. <u>PRESENTATIONS:</u> People's United Wealth portfolio update by advisors Mark Cross-Powers & People's United Government Banking representative Barbara Raths. Mark presented the latest quarterly market review/outlook, including Hudson's portfolio performance. The discussion revolved around both domestic and international developed and emerging markets and what drives economic themes. Part of the discussion involved current investments, including Wells Fargo which Ed continues to review & monitor along with our portfolio manager, Chris Lucas. Assets and allocations were reviewed, including performance results. Since investing with People's United Wealth in 2014, Trustee invested Capital Reserve funds have earned an average of \$73,210/month in market appreciation, dividends & interest (less fees). Another side discussion involved a Library Trust being brought in under the People's umbrella which would look like one of the Trustee Trusts, but would have Library Trustee's as designees on the account.
