MINUTES OF THE March 22, 2012 MEETING

- P.M. by Trustee Lathrop. In 1. Meeting was called to order at 2:50 attendance were Trustees Duchesne & Schibanoff, Finance Director Kathy Carpentier, and Clerk to the Trustees Paula DeAngelis. Also in attendance was Bob Robbins and Colleen Farley of MorganStanley/Smith Barney.
- 2. The floor was opened up to Bob Robbins of MSSB. Bob presented a couple reports showing earnings and growth. He spoke about risk in the market. Bonds are too risky right now to purchase. Stocks in companies with high ratings according to the S&P (usually world-wide), and companies with low risk, are better to buy right now. Stocks are cheaper to buy relative to their percentage earning/returns. When held to 70/30, Bob tends to purchase convertible bonds that can turn into stocks or he may buy stocks that pay a higher dividend. Harry asked about fixed mutual funds. Bob said that fixed mutual funds have set prices and contain a group of stocks. When risk gets too high, he sells off a little stock to take a "profit" dividend. Bob expects to see another 10 - 15% of growth by December.
- 3. The minutes from the meeting of February 23, 2012 were reviewed and accepted.
