I. PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF ZBA BYLAWS (HTC §143)

For the past year and a half, the members of the Zoning Board of Adjustment have been discussing proposed revisions of the Board's bylaws, mostly involving rearrangement of the existing regulations for clarity, together with some updating in response to changes of applicable New Hampshire Statutes by the State Legislature since the last revision of the bylaws. This will be the third of three public hearings for the purpose of ratifying the proposed amendments. A copy of the proposed version of the bylaws is available for inspection at the Community Development Department office at Town Hall.
